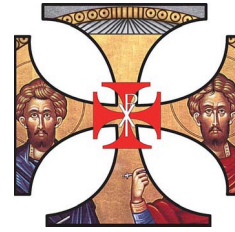

Membership in Philoptochos is:

Philanthropy: Experience something larger than yourself

Fellowship: Philoptochos offers the opportunity to meet wonderful people, meet new friends

Faith in Action: Philoptochos offers the opportunity to serve the Church while working alongside your sisters in Christ

Invite, Embrace, Involve! Membership growth and retention should be an ongoing commitment and goal of the entire Chapter throughout the entire year.

Membership Qualifications

Associate Membership: A non-Greek Orthodox woman married to a Greek Orthodox man, Greek Orthodox men, a non-Greek Orthodox man married to a Greek Orthodox woman. *Associate members participate in all the privileges of a Full Member except for the right to vote*

Financial Stewardship Offering is based on the fair share Christian Stewardship concept.
