Project: Philoptochos Can Can Club

Objective: The project's premise is to offer assistance to local non-denominational ministries who are experiencing difficulty in fulfilling the needs of the poor during this economic downturn.

Recipients of this project:

- The Greater Birmingham Ministries is a non-profit non-denominational Christian ministry dedicated to improving the lives of low-income families.
- Greater Birmingham Community Garden, adjacent to low-income housing, teaches women and children how to grow fresh vegetables to supplement their diet.

In executing this project, some suggested activities include:

- Address and energize the entire parish following a Sunday Divine Liturgy, re: the Philoptochos Can Can Food Drive.
- Request parishioners to sign up for the food drive and provide non-perishable food items monthly. Items are to be placed in a grocery cart located in the church and are picked up by the Ministry.
- Distribute fifty bags of groceries weekly to needy families as a result of the food drive.
- Volunteer to work in the community garden and donate extra produce to the ministry that parishioners have grown in their own backyard gardens.
