to discuss issues facing our young women today.
Program included a presentation of the “Four types of
love” (Eros, Stergo, Phileo, and Agape).
Sent invitations to girls in Sunday School, Girl Scouts,
and Greek Dance Troupes.
Publicize in Faith Section of local paper, e-mails, and
church bulletin.

The Angels in Bloom Project could be continued given additional
presentations on the struggles of parenting, importance of a healthy marriage, the survival of the family
through the teenage years, menopause, and aging.
