Search for treatment facilities and programs around the country. Look for facilities near you or in other geographic areas. Look for residential treatment centers, outpatient treatment programs, or hospital inpatient programs. Find facilities providing services for adolescents or adults, services in a language other than English, or services for the hearing-impaired. Look for facilities providing programs or groups targeted to clients with specific problems or issues (persons with co-occurring mental and substance abuse disorders, adolescents, court-referred individuals, or for Lesbian, gay, bisexual, or transgendered clients (LGBT). Discover the types of payment accepted, and whether payment assistance is available.

ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE TREATMENT SERVICES:

Search more than 11,000 drug and alcohol abuse and addiction treatment facilities and programs around the country. In addition to the search categories above, find facilities providing targeted programs or groups for persons with HIV/AIDS; pregnant or postpartum women; women only; men only; seniors/older adults; or DUI/DWI offenders.

MENTAL HEALTH TREATMENT SERVICES:

Search more than 8,000 mental health treatment facilities or programs around the country. In addition to the search categories above, look for facilities providing targeted programs or groups for persons with post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD); traumatic brain injury (TBI); Alzheimer's or other dementia; adults with serious mental illness (SMI); young adults (ages 18-25); or veterans. Find facilities providing crisis intervention or psychiatric emergency walk-in services.
