Your Annual Chapter Budget Is...

- A prediction or estimate of your income and expenses for the coming year.
- It is aspirational.
- The more experience you have creating budgets, the better you will become at predicting your income and expenses.

- When budgeting for fundraising events, you want to generate enough income to cover all expenses and leave a profit.
- The profit from your events, together with your tray collections and donations, will provide the funding necessary to pay your National and Metropolis commitments and all your local expenses.

Begin by reviewing your income and expenses for the last several years...

- How much total income have you raised on average?
- How much of the income comes from fundraising events?
- How much of the income is raised through trays and donations?
- What are your average expenses per year?
- How much do you spend on local expenses/donations?
- How much do you disburse for Metropolis commitments?
- How much do you disburse for National commitments?

Income

- Using past years' income as a guide, project the **total gross** income you will take in from each fundraising event you plan to hold in the coming year; list each event separately.
- Again, using past years as a guide, project the total income you will raise from tray collections and donations.
